She doesn't make large canes and she uses every little bit of clay to make some interesting accent canes for all sorts of projects. You will be more creative and productive if you have your cane inventory waiting for you when an idea hits. This class is for all levels of expertise, the only requirement is that you know how to make a Skinner blend and that you come to class with your Skinner blends and plugs already made.
